Apples

<i>Early</i>	<i>Early-Midseason</i>	<i>Midseason</i>
Gravenstein **	Fuji	Cosmic Crisp
Yellow Transparent *	Spartan *	Honeycrisp Akane

For cross-pollination, choose varieties in the same or adjacent columns

* Varieties are partially self-fertile but benefit from a nearby pollinator

** Varieties are sterile and require two cross-pollinators

Pears

Shinseiki	<i>Self-fertile</i>

Cherries

<i>Variety</i>	<i>Pollinator</i>
Bing	Rainier or Van

Sweetheart *	<i>Self-fertile</i>

*Also a good pollinator for other varieties
